**Reports of Local Unions:** IAM Lodge 1947 is expecting an additional 150 employees to receive a lay-off notice. NALC Local 125 will be operating with four fewer carriers. Sheet Metal Workers Local 18 have ten employees on lay-off. Laborers Local 330 have over 200 employees not working. Alliance Laundry is laying off 74 employees, of which 23 are voluntary. CWA Local 4622 is losing 45 technicians in WI.
